

General Membership Information

- Access to two championship 18-hole golf courses
- Talons Course is a 4-time host of the ATB Classic Mackenzie Tour.
- A maximum of 850 shareholders; 425 per course, allowing for the best access to tee times of any private club in Calgary.
- Our facilities include 2 lounge areas with full-service menus as well as snack shacks for each course.
- 3 Food & Beverage member-only events monthly.
- Access to a boardroom and banquet facility for your private events.
- Practice facilities include a double ended driving range, a chipping green and 3 putting greens.
- Longest playing season of any private club in the city.

Membership Categories - Parent Accounts

PRINCIPAL MEMBER

- Requires the purchase of an equity share of the Club
- Has full use of all the Club's facilities
- May play at any time when the courses are open for play
- Obtain 1 vote for all decisions taken to the Membership

YOUNG PROFESSIONAL MEMBER

- Available to those who are 35 years of age and younger
- Has full use of all the Club's facilities
- May play any time during weekdays (except statutory holidays) and after the first 3 hours of tee times on Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays or immediately after all groups made up of only Principle Members
- A non-refundable share deposit applies annually that is held by the Club and goes towards a purchase of a future share each year

ANNUAL WEEKDAY MEMBER

- May play golf Monday through Friday (excluding holidays)
- Otherwise has full access to the Club's facilities
- A limited number of these memberships are available every season

DESIGNATE MEMBER

- Designated by a shareholder to use the Club on their behalf for the season
- Requires an application and Management and Board approval
- Has full use of all the Club's facilities
- Has the same guest and tee time privileges as a Principal
- Can only play under this membership for a maximum of one year

INVITATIONAL MEMBER

- Has full use of all the Club's facilities
- Requires an application and Management and Board approval
- A limited number of these memberships are available every season
- Can play under this membership for a maximum of one year

CLASS B MEMBERSHIP

- Has the same golfing privileges as an Annual Weekday member
- Must have been a shareholder previous to becoming a Class B member
- May play golf Monday through Friday (excluding holidays)
- Otherwise has full access to the Club's facilities
- A limited number of these memberships are available every season

Membership Categories - Dependent Accounts

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

- Has full use of all the Club's Facilities
- May play any time during weekdays (except statutory holidays) and on Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays immediately after all groups made up of only Principle Members
- Can be any immediate family member (i.e. spouse, brother, sister, mother, father etc.) at a limit of 2 per shareholder

INTERMEDIATE MEMBER

- Has full use of all of the Club's facilities
- Has the same playing privileges as an Associate Member
- Subcategories:
 - Senior Intermediate: ages 25-35
 - Intermediate: ages 18-24
 - Student Intermediate: ages 18-24 with proof of school enrolment

JUNIOR MEMBER

- Ages 12-18
- Full use of Club facilities. Can use the Links Lounge with the supervision of an adult member.
- May play during weekdays except for statutory holidays at any time except between the hours of 12:30 to 2:00 pm (unless there are unused tee times during these hours on the day of play) and after 12:30 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays.

JUVENILE MEMBER

- For Members under the age of 12
- Must always be under the direct supervision of an adult member while on the Club premises or on the golf courses
- May play at the same times as Junior Member, provided the Juvenile Member is accompanied by an adult Member

SPONSORED JUNIOR MEMBER

- Has full use of all the Club's Facilities
- Requires an application and Head Pro approval
- May play during weekdays except for statutory holidays at any time except between the hours of 12:30 to 2:00 pm (unless there are unused tee times during these hours on the day of play) and after 12:30 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays.

ASSOCIATE AFTER 5 MEMBER

- Has full use of all the Club's Facilities
- May play any time after 5:00 p.m. any day of the week
- Can be any immediate family member (i.e. spouse, brother, sister, mother, father etc.) at a limit of 2 per shareholder

SPOUSE RANGE/SOCIAL MEMBER

- Has full use of all the Club's Facilities including golf practice facilities

Guest Policies

- Any Member in good standing, except Juvenile Members, may bring a guest at his or her own expense to use the Club's facilities and play golf on the Club's courses, except during leagues or during special events for which guests may not be eligible.
- Guests of Members are not permitted to play between 6:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on weekends and statutory holidays.
- A Member may bring a maximum of three guests per tee time.
- No Member may extend privileges to a guest which differ from those he or she is entitled.
- A Member must accompany his or her guest and is responsible to ensure that the guest's green fees are paid. Members are responsible for the dress and behaviour of their guests.
- A Member bringing a guest to use the Club facilities is liable for any debt that such guest may incur in the Club and for any damage done by such guest to Club property or surrounding property in accordance with the provision of sections 16.01 to 16.04.
- Members may not bring a non-playing guest to use the driving range or the Club's practice facilities unless approved by a Club Professional who will have the sole discretion to approve or disapprove the request.
